# Ithaca Club win vital funding for equipment

ITHACA Caloundra City Life Saving Club, who patrol Bulcock Beach, recently received an unexpected visitor.

Member for Fisher Mal Brough called in to look at the equipment that the Club purchased with the \$5000 grant from the Australian Government Department of Health (Patrolling Clubs - Safety Equipment Fund).

The funding program has been a federal initiative introduced to help keep the beach and community safe.

"We were delighted to receive this funding along with surf clubs, it made a big difference for our small club, which as you are aware, receives no funding from Surf Life Saving as we're affiliated with Royal Life Saving," club captain Lynda Barry said.

"It enabled us to purchase a new motor to replace our very well used one.

"We were also able to upgrade our defibrillator, a necessary part of our first aid equipment. Most importantly, it allowed the club to buy two digital

radios, one as a base radio, and one for use in the IRB following surf life saving conversion to a digital radio system at the start of this season.

"Every surf life saving club was provided radios by SLS but we have had to fund them ourselves." Bulcock Beach is becoming an increasingly

popular destination for locals and visitors. Last year, the volunteer lifesavers undertook 175 rescues from Bulcock Beach and in the Passage.
