

Two saved as kayak capsized

Two youths were rescued by Caloundra lifesavers when their kayak capsized in choppy seas, 230 metres from Kings Beach, yesterday afternoon.

Lifesavers used a reel and line to tow the youths and their kayak to shore.

At Miami, lifesavers rescued a girl, 14, who was carried out 75 metres in a rip.

Two Tweed Heads Air-Sea Rescue boats searched for a boat off Cook Island, near Fingal Beach, at midday yesterday.

Two divers had reported that their companion and boat were missing. Both were later found.

The boat, which had engine trouble, had drifted off course.
