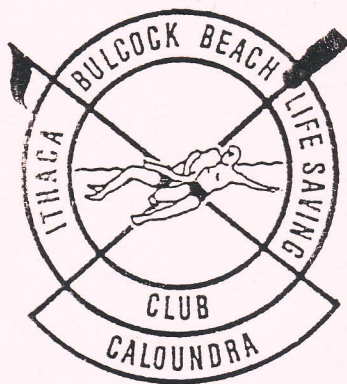

The club has now completed its forty-fifth season.

CLUBHOUSE:

The Caloundra City Council assisted in repairing clubhouse windows and installing security screens.

MEMBERSHIP:

Attendance at the first training session on 25 September 1993 totalled 8 (14 1992/93) but grew to 17, a decrease of 16 on last season. Attendance at the pool was more regular compared to last season. There were over 10 new members. Some members are only temporary, joining the Club to gain a particular award before leaving. The reasons vary; being for employment opportunity or just self achievement.

Thirty members (35 last season) attended weekend patrolling at Caloundra. Of these, 6 attended (9 1992/93) on four or more occasions and 16 attended (14 1992/93) on 8 or more separate occasions. Of the 30 patrolling weekends (30 1992/93) the average attendance of members at the coast was 11 occasions (8 last season).

CARNIVAL:

The Club participated in the Royal Life Saving Society Queensland's Beach and Initiative Carnivals. At the Beach Carnival the Club gained second place overall.

AWARDS:

Club training is conducted on Friday nights for one and a half hours at the Ithaca Baths. Beach training is conducted at Bulcock Beach, Caloundra during patrolling weekends and some winter weekends.

The Club again won the G.L. Jones Shield, awarded by The Royal Life Saving Society Queensland for the registered Club obtaining highest number of points relating to Society awards gained.

PATROLLING:

This season the club patrolled Bulcock Beach, Caloundra, every weekend from 18 September 1993 to 5 April 1994 (20 September 1992 to 11 April 1993: last season). Patrols were conducted from at least 10.00 am to 4.00 pm each day. Christmas/New Year and Easter Periods were patrolled.

The club conducted official patrols over all weekends. A total of 66 days (62 days of 366 hours for 1992/93) of 391 hours in attendance at our beach.

The records of the two boats' operations were totalled at 206½ hours over 63 separate days as compared to 141½ hours and over 61 days last season.
