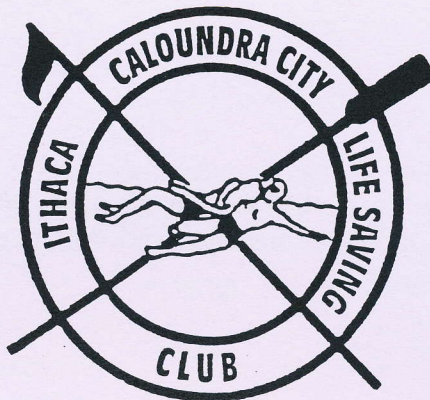

The Club has completed its forty-sixth season. This season again saw an improvement, with an increase in active members and continued and regular patrols throughout the season.

MISSION STATEMENT

To achieve the highest level in the delivery of Aquatic Safety, Rescue and Emergency Care with the support of volunteer members within a family based environment.

MEMBERSHIP

Attendance at Ithaca Pool training improved this season with members, both new and continuing members, attending on a more regular basis.

All weekends (36 last season) and public holidays during the summer season from 18.9.99 to 30.4.00 were patrolled at Caloundra between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm. A total of 441 patrol hours (438 hours last season).

The Caloundra City Council Beach Lifeguards utilised the club's facilities for week-day patrol as and when conducted by the Council.

YEAR 2000 CELEBRATIONS

A major activity was conducted on Bulcock Beach and the adjacent Esplanade, which attracted over twenty thousand people through the day culminating in a fire-works display at mid-night. Patrols were conducted from 6.00am to 6.00pm with the first aid room remaining open and operational until 1am the following morning. During the day and night there were only 7 minor rescues and 19 prevention actions and varied first aid cases.

AWARDS

Club training is conducted on Wednesday nights for one and a half hours at the Ithaca Baths. Beach training is conducted at Bulcock Beach, Caloundra during patrolling weekends and some winter weekends.

All available awards of The Royal Life Saving Society - Australia are listed, with Club awards gained shown.

PATROLLING

This season the Club patrolled Bulcock Beach , Caloundra, weekends from 18 September 1999 to 30 April 2000 (12 Sept 1998 to 26 April 2000 last season). Patrols were conducted from 10.00am to 4.00pm and on occasions from 9.00am to 5.00pm.

The Club conducted official patrols over patrol weekends including Christmas, Boxing, New Years and Australia Day holidays as well as Easter weekend. A total of 73 days of 441 hours (72 days of 438 hours for 1998/99) in attendance. Patrols at Caloundra were maintained with low numbers at Bulcock Beach and not Golden Beach. The continued patrolling of the still waters of Caloundra between the Caloundra Bar and Golden Beach using rescue boats ensured a wide coverage of area with small numbers and the ability to reduce official patrols at Golden Beach.

FOUNDATION

On 1 December 1992 the Club agreed to the formation of a FOUNDATION, with the following eleven goals and conditions:

1. The aim of the Foundation is the creation of a capital fund capable of generating an annual income, part of which will be used to maintain the operation of the patrolling activities of the Club.
2. The principle to be developed by the generation of funds from sources such as legacies, bequests, donations, fundraising activities specifically designated for the purpose and transfers as approved by the Management Committee from the Club's general funds and/or fundraising activities.
3. A principle amount of \$100,000 be the initial goal.
4. Annual distribution be restricted to a maximum of 50% of the annual income generated by the Foundation.
5. Decisions on the distribution to be made by the Management Committee.
6. The signatures for the Foundation accounts be the usual Club signatories.
7. The bank books and investment receipts remain in the custody of the Club's Honorary Treasurer.
8. All expenses directly attributable to the Foundation be paid out of the Foundation.
9. All donations/bequests to the Foundation be acknowledged in the Club's Annual Report.
10. The Foundation's funds to be available to the Club general account on a loan basis, only in times of extreme financial hardship and with the approval of the Club's Management Committee.
11. These Foundation conditions to form part of the Club's By-Laws, and as such, can only be altered or repealed as per Rule 2\5 of the Club's Rules (Constitution).

On 13 May 1993 the Club started the Foundation with \$10,000 and continued with a further investments.

The balance as at 30 June 2000 was \$92113.22 (at cost).
