ANNUAL REPORT

The Club is a professional Life Saving organisation and has three main activities, which are:-

- Maintaining Beach Patrols on Bulcock Beach, Caloundra;
- Training and development of Members and the Public in Life Saving techniques; and
- Increase Participation & Volunteering.

The present Clubhouse was constructed in 1989 and is located adjacent to Bulcock Beach, at the western end of the beach. The Clubhouse is constructed on stumps/piles with half the Clubhouse elevated above the beach.

Equipment of the Club is modern and contains all the necessary items of Life Saving Club equipment.

The main rescue equipment is the Inflatable Rescue Boats (IRB), rescue/paddle boards, rescue tubes and first aid equipment.

The Club maintains Beach Patrols during weekends and public holidays over the summer months of the year (September through to May).

Membership of the Club is open for application to any member of the public willing to assist the Club in whatever manner they are able to help the Club achieve its mission. The bulk of memberships are people aged 7 to 80 years.

CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Our club plays a crucial role in ensuring the safety of beachgoers and supporting local communities. However, the club has been facing significant challenges due to a dwindling number of volunteers. This report highlights the struggles associated with the shortage of volunteers and its impact on the club's operations and services.

Decline in Volunteer Numbers

Over the past few years, the club has seen a notable decline in the number of active volunteers. Contributing factors include changing work-life commitments, increased demands on time, and a shift in societal priorities. As a result, fewer individuals are available to dedicate time to life-saving activities, training, and patrols.

Impact on Operations

The lack of volunteers has directly impacted the club's ability to fulfill its core mission. Key areas affected include:

- **Reduced Patrols:** With fewer members available, the club has had to reduce the number of patrols on the beach, which increases the risk to public safety.
- **Burnout of Existing Volunteers:** The remaining volunteers are experiencing burnout due to increased workloads.
- **Training and Skill Development:** The club has struggled to maintain its training programs, as fewer volunteers are available to participate in and lead these sessions, resulting in a gap in essential life-saving skills.
- **Junior Lifeguard Program:** When the club shifted to Saturday only patrols, we for the first time in 21 years had to cancel the Junior program, as the instructors were not available on Saturdays.

Community Engagement and Recruitment

Efforts to recruit new volunteers have also been met with challenges. Despite campaigns and outreach efforts, it has been difficult to engage younger generations or attract individuals with the necessary commitment. Additionally, there is a growing competition for volunteer time from other community organisations and activities.

The lack of volunteers poses a serious challenge to our ability to maintain its essential services. Without a significant increase in volunteer numbers, the club may face further reductions in patrols and support.

We held an emergency meeting in December 2023 for all members, and then committed to patrol only on Saturdays and public holidays to the rest of the season. This meant we could have a patrol.



CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

The continuing change with the Caloundra Bar has meant that we have no access to the ocean from our clubhouse, meaning we cannot respond to an emergency on the ocean front. We also have limited access to the Bribie Bar due to sandbanks along the way, and the time it takes to navigate this.

I would like to thank our team of dedicated members, from the ones with many years of experience to the new members with their thirst for knowledge.

As you can see from the above table, all of our figures have dramatically decreased from the previous seasons. This is to be expected given that we did not complete full patrol days.

The main reason for this is the lack of volunteers at the club and the changing conditions with the Caloundra Bar.

The trivia fundraiser in August 2023 was a resounding success, exceeding all expectations. With enthusiastic participation from the community. The night was filled with fun and friendly competition, with local businesses generously donating prizes, and participants showing strong support through raffle ticket purchases and donations. The overwhelming turnout and contributions demonstrated the community's commitment to the club, making the event both financially and socially rewarding. Big thanks to Izzie Forsyth, for being my partner to help organise and run the evening together.



CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Just after the trivia night, in September 2023 we held an open day. There was a marketing plan developed and advertising was through radio advertising, letterbox drops, clubhouse signs and social media. The open day event proved to be a great success, drawing an impressive number of attendees and significantly raising awareness of the Volunteer Life Saving Club's mission.

The strategic promotion through social media, and community bulletins effectively reached a wide audience, generating strong interest in the open day. On the day, visitors engaged with demonstrations, met with current volunteers, and learned about the importance of life-saving work. The event not only attracted potential new volunteers but also strengthened ties with the community, showcasing the club's impact and encouraging future support. Again, Izzie was a driving force with this campaign.

PATROLLING

Patrols are conducted on all weekends and public holidays during the summer season and are overseen by:

- * Club officials (Regular unannounced inspections carried out);
- * The Royal Life Saving Society (members of the Combined Clubs Committee); and
- * Surf Life Saving (SLSA Duty Officers visit the Club regularly and provide guidance and advice).

The Club holds a Patrol Service Agreement with Sunshine Coast Regional Council, wherein the Club agrees to patrol the beach from September School Holidays through to the beginning of May, during designated hours. Council Beach Life Guards (subcontracted to Surf Life Saving Queensland, since October 2012) utilise the Club facilities and equipment for weekday beach patrols. The aforementioned groups ensure the quality of patrols is maintained to the highest standard. Every patrol has an allocated Patrol Captain who must be qualified for control of all of the patrol functions (i.e.: IRB, Radio, First Aid, etc)

Every patrol member must wear the Club patrol uniform, which consists of red shorts, yellow shirt (indicating 'Beach Patrol') and a quartered red and yellow skull cap, whilst on patrol.

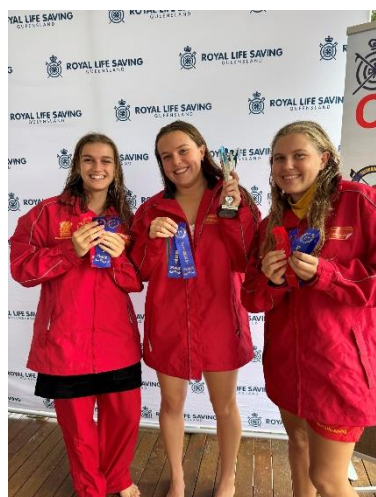
All First aid cases are continued to be treated in the first aid room, unless the patient is located away from the Clubhouse, in which case they are treated at the scene.

Local Laws advisory – the Club records incidents where advice is given to the public in respect to local law matters including:

- * Dogs within the bathing reserve;
- * Fishing within the bathing reserve;
- * Smoking between the flags; and
- * Boats/Jet Skis in the bathing reserve.

CPR AND DEFIB AWARENESS COURSES.

Club Members, Patricia and Tony Barry, Paul Seto and Doug Golder, continued to hold CPR and Defib Awareness Courses throughout the year, advising and servicing about 70 – 80 local residents from churches, the Arts Centre, driving clubs and Migrant organisations.
