ANNUAL REPORT

The Club is a professional Life Saving organisation and has three main activities, which are:-

- Maintaining Beach Patrols on Bulcock Beach, Caloundra;
- Training and development of Members and the Public in Life Saving techniques; and
- Increase Participation & Volunteering.

The present Clubhouse was constructed in 1989 and is located adjacent to Bulcock Beach, at the western end of the beach. The Clubhouse is constructed on stumps/piles with half the Clubhouse elevated above the beach.

Equipment of the Club is modern and contains all the necessary items of Life Saving Club equipment.

The main rescue equipment is the Inflatable Rescue Boats (IRB), rescue/paddle boards, rescue tubes and first aid equipment.

The Club maintains Beach Patrols during weekends and public holidays over the summer months of the year (September through to May).

Membership of the Club is open for application to any member of the public willing to assist the Club in whatever manner they are able to help the Club achieve its mission. The bulk of memberships are people aged 7 to 80 years.

CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

The 2024–25 season was another significant one for Ithaca-Caloundra City Life Saving Club, marked by both challenges and achievements as we continued to uphold our mission of delivering aquatic safety, rescue and emergency care at Bulcock Beach.

Patrols commenced on **14 September 2024** and concluded on **5 May 2025**, spanning **42 patrol days** across weekends and public holidays. Over this period, our volunteers contributed an impressive **1,869.5 hours**, averaging **8.8 members per patrol**. This represents a tremendous commitment by our members, who have continued to provide professional and reliable service to the Caloundra community despite ongoing volunteer shortages.

Patrol Activity

Our patrol teams oversaw a combined **67,254 beach and water users**, including **45,142 beachgoers**, **21,246 swimmers**, and monitoring **686 watercrafts**. These figures reflect the growing popularity of Bulcock Beach, particularly during the peak holiday periods, and highlight the importance of our presence in maintaining community safety.

Key patrol statistics for the season include:

- **11 rescues performed**, spread across flagged areas, the Caloundra Bar, and outside flagged zones.
- **30 preventative actions**, preventing potential incidents from escalating.
- **33 first aid cases**, the majority being cuts, grazes and marine stings, as well as incidents involving stonefish spines.
- **4 lost persons reunited with family or carers**
- **40 interactions involving local laws enforcement.**

Importantly, no resuscitations were required this season, reflecting both effective preventative measures and timely interventions by patrol members.

Environmental Conditions

Environmental change continues to play a major role in shaping patrol operations. The **Caloundra Bar and Bribie Island break-through** remain unstable, with shifting sandbanks making IRB launches increasingly difficult. In fact, our IRB was unable to operate at times due to sand build-up, requiring adjustments in patrol strategies. These conditions also contributed to an increase in first aid cases and rescues outside the flagged area, as swimmers and water users encountered the unpredictable waterway.



CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Training and Development

Member training and development remain a cornerstone of our success. Over the season, **98 new qualifications** were achieved by members, covering awards such as Bronze Medallion, First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation, and IRB crew and driver qualifications. This growth strengthens the skill base of our patrol teams and ensures compliance with Royal Life Saving Society Queensland standards.

Volunteers and Membership

One of the ongoing challenges for the Club has been maintaining volunteer numbers. For much of the season, patrols were limited to Saturdays and public holidays. However, I am pleased to report that membership is stabilising, with several new members completing training. This puts us in a stronger position to possibly expanding our service in the **2025–26 season**, particularly during busy school holiday periods when our presence is most critical.

Acknowledgements

I would like to extend my sincere thanks to every volunteer who has contributed to patrols, training, and club operations throughout the season. Each hour volunteered represents a personal commitment to the safety of our beachgoers and visitors. The combined effort of our patrol members, committee, and trainers ensures that Ithaca-Caloundra City Life Saving Club remains an integral part of the Caloundra community.

In summary, the 2024–25 season demonstrated both the resilience of our Club and the dedication of our members. Despite environmental challenges and volunteer shortages, we successfully met our obligations, kept the community safe, and strengthened the foundation for future seasons. I am confident that with continued growth in membership and training, we will be well-positioned to service the community.

PATROLLING

Patrols are conducted on all weekends and public holidays during the summer season and are overseen by:

- * Club officials (Regular unannounced inspections carried out);
- * The Royal Life Saving Society (members of the Combined Clubs Committee); and
- * Surf Life Saving (SLSA Duty Officers visit the Club regularly and provide guidance and advice).

The Club holds a Patrol Service Agreement with Sunshine Coast Regional Council, wherein the Club agrees to patrol the beach from September School Holidays through to the beginning of May, during designated hours. Council Beach Life Guards (subcontracted to Surf Life Saving Queensland, since October 2012) utilise the Club facilities and equipment for weekday beach patrols. The aforementioned groups ensure the quality of patrols is maintained to the highest standard. Every patrol has an allocated Patrol Captain who must be qualified for control of all of the patrol functions (i.e.: IRB, Radio, First Aid, etc)

Every patrol member must wear the Club patrol uniform, which consists of red shorts, yellow shirt (indicating 'Beach Patrol') and a quartered red and yellow skull cap, whilst on patrol.

- * Smoking between the flags; and
- * Boats/Jet Skis in the bathing reserve.

The passage is now a very dangerous and rapidly changing waterway, which has created significant issues for users and rescue personnel. The waterway now has multiple pathways as indicated in the picture above.

There has been an increase in the number of first aid cases at the adjoining beach this last season, due to the changing environment.

The Caloundra Bar continues to change and split up in the season, with the now Bribie Bar continuing to widen and be unstable. This has led to the Club not being able to get the rescue boat out either Bar, due to sand build up. The water quality is also being monitored by various groups, due to the little water movement.

Discussions with the Sunshine Coast Council have taken place and they have advised the Club to remain in position while nature is still settling. Although the Club have not performed as many rescues etc., our position has provided a safer swimming environment for the community at large.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Grey Medallion held in August 2024 had 31 enrolled, but as often the case, five did not appear on the day. This was the first year the Grey Medallion was held without a pool session, due to Grand Pacific's pool being closed for renovation. In spite of this, feedback from those who attended indicated that all greatly valued the course and their motivation to participate was obvious. A very big thankyou to the five members who helped on this day. Numbers for this course have been reducing since Covid – a reflection perhaps of the phenomenon of disinterest in community awareness that is perceived in the reduction of volunteering.

One course was held for CPR Awareness. Demand for this is high but more volunteers are needed to run these greatly valued courses among older members of our local community who can't afford to pay. On the 7th of July 2025 Jim McClelland and Imelda Potton conducted an awareness session at the Edgewater over 50s Lifestyle Community at Bli Bli.

The Migrant session went well with the leadership of Katelyn Miles.

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This year the Club's financial results reflected a slight reduction in overall income when compared with the five-year average. The primary reason for this decrease was the absence of our junior lifeguard program, which has historically provided both community engagement and a reliable revenue stream. While this impacted income, it is expected to be a short-term change and the Club remains in a strong financial position overall.

On the expense side, total outgoings were down slightly compared to recent years, demonstrating continued prudent management. The main exception to this was insurance costs, which have again increased and continue to represent a significant portion of our operating expenditure. Importantly, the Club did not undertake any major asset purchases during the year, ensuring resources remained available for essential operations and maintenance.

A highlight of the year was the commissioning of a new all-terrain vehicle (ATV), made possible through the generous support of the Queensland State Government Gambling Community Fund. This asset will greatly assist in the delivery of lifesaving services on our beaches. In addition, our Foundation Fund has continued its steady growth, now holding a balance of approximately \$390,000, providing a strong and sustainable financial base for the Club's future.

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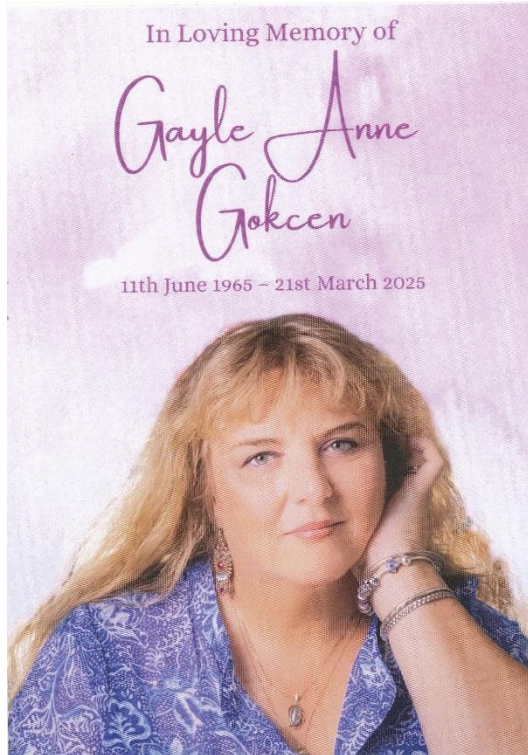

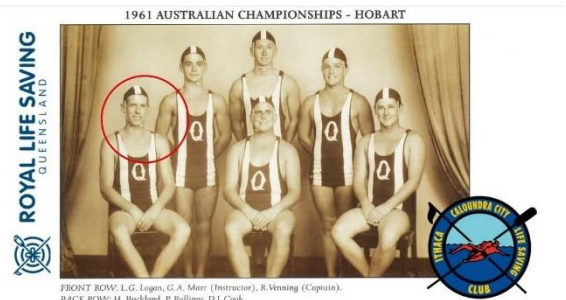
